So my first Council meeting was 12th July just before the AGM in Manchester. The main focus of this meeting was to agree the elections and co-options to Council and to agree what committee's and boards the Council Members were on. I'm on the Audit Committee and as Audit isn't my functional area should provide me with some good new learning and a different perspective to offer. The Chair of this committee is my good friend Ken Finch, a former North West and North Wales President, so I know I'm in good hands.

We also had to sign any declarations of interest and had a copy of the guidelines for Council Members to adhere to.

There is a Council Induction meeting on 25th July but I'm not able to attend as I'll be on my holidays but I have been before two years ago when I became the North West Society President. At the Induction we heard all about the different Committees and Boards and the terms of reference for each, including Council, what the roles of an Institute Council Member are, who all our main contacts are and the current governance structure of the Institute. It's a bit similar to the Induction pack that I compiled for new Council Members to the North West, but a lot thinner.

My first official engagement as Institute Council Member was the President's dinner on the evening of 12 July in the Grand Hall at Manchester Town Hall. It is a magnificent venue and I had some great people on my table from a mix of students, other CIPFA regions and CIPFA staff so I was in good company. It wasn't a late one for me as I had to be on the regional stand at 7.45am the next day. It was Institute President Andy Burns first formal occasion too and he gave a great opening speech to highlight his plans for the year ahead.

So that's about it for my first blog, not that much to say as we've only had one Council meeting but I'll be doing quarterly blogs from now on to let you all know what's going on. Next up for me is the next Council meeting on 12th October and the Audit Committee on the same day, so it'll be great to catch with the other members again as after the first one it was straight to the AGM and then onto the main conference the next day.
