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### **Drivers for Reform**

## **Reform requires Innovation**

## **Reform requires Innovative Funding**

- The £30 million Change Fund in 2015-16 provides funding for upfront investment to achieve longer term benefits
- Alternative funding models promote outcome based contracts with external investment
- Collaborative procurement offers opportunities for savings and joined up government
