

Introduction

Welcome to the revamped CIPFA Residential & Nursing Care Benchmarking Club Report.

This report compares data collected from your authority in the Adult Social Care Financial Return (ASC-FR) with the data from the other authorities in your tier. The reports provide you with insights into your Residential and Nursing Care service that is externally provided. The aim is to enable you to understand your organisation's costs and performance, gather key management information and highlight areas of concern and where savings can be made.

It includes an executive summary and a detailed analysis of processes, workload and unit cost for each Primary Support Reason. The summary comprises data on both your internal and external provision, whereas the focus of each Support Reason analysis is on external provision data only.

As this is the first year we are running this updated club, please note that we are open to suggestions. If you wish to see more data analysis on certains areas of the Residential and Nursing Care service, we will be happy to collaborate with you to provide the additional analysis.

The club members will also receive the following outputs:

• A comparative report in which your data is compared against the data from your statistical Nearest Neighbours;

• The text questions submitted, spell & grammar checked and collated into Word documents;

• An interactive tool (Excel), which allows you to look in more detail at your external and internal provision. The graphs related to the internal provision will be available only to those club members that have submitted this part of the CIPFA questionnaire;

• All members will be eligible to attend the club review meeting.



General Information


Averages: The average is the unweighted mean value for the group. This average value ignores missing data, or data that have been excluded.

Comparison of Resident Unit Cost for Physical Support for 65+ Adult Group




2) Scatter Plots: Used for showing distributions


The scatter plots are used to show the distribution of costs compared to your population size.

The trend line is based on a linear modelling of the cost and population variables. In other words, it shows the relationship between the size of your Authority and the costs it incurs, all other things held constant.


Your Authority is a red dot situated either on, below or above the trend line. The bright green dots represent all other authorities.


Distribution of Cost and Activity Active Weeks Analysis

Summary

Total Gross Expenditure for Residential and Nursing Care by Age Group



Barchester's total gross expenditure for Residential and Nursing care is £35,798k: 52% of this amount are spent on adults aged 18-64 (whereas the London Boroughs spend on average 46% for the same age group.)

The total gross expenditure for adults aged 65 and over is $\pm 17,087$ k. Barchester thus spends 5 percentage points less for this category compared with younger adults.

Thus, Barchester dedicates 52% of its total gross expenditure to provide 13,586 weeks to younger adults while it provides 25,893 weeks to older adults by spending 66% of its resources.






The bar charts on the left show the gross current expenditure per week by Primary Support Reason for younger adults (18-64 age group) for both Residential and Nursing Care.

For Residential Care, the highest unit cost for Barchester is for Learning Disabilities Support which is not in line with the other London Boroughs.

On the contrary, the London Boroughs have the highest expenditure per week when providing young adults with Support with M&C (\pounds 3,013).

Regarding the cost in Nursing Care, London Boroughs reported the highest unit costs for Learning Disabilities Support, followed by Mental Health Support.

The bar charts on the left show the gross current expenditure per week by Primary Support Reason for older adults (65+ age group) for both Residential and Nursing Care.

For Residential Care, the highest unit cost for Barchester is for Sensory Support which is not in line with the other London Boroughs.

On the contrary, the London Boroughs have the highest expenditure per week when providing young adults with Learning Disabilities Support (£1,108).

Regarding the cost in Nursing Care, London Boroughs reported the highest unit costs for Support with M&C, followed by Learning Disabilities Support.














Comparison of Resident Unit Cost for Physical Support for 18-64 Adult Group

London Boroughs spend on average $\pounds 1,023$ per week of residential care, which is 3% higher than cost per week of nursing care.

Barchester has reported a higher cost per week of residential care (£1,006) compared to the cost per week of nursing care (£991).





Proportion of Sensory Support Weeks to Total Number of Weeks (all supports) | Residential and Nursing Care










Comparison of Number of Sensory Support Weeks for 65+
























Proportion of Learning Disability Support Weeks to Total Number of Weeks (all supports) | Residential and Nursing Care



























Barchester has reported a lower cost per week of residential care $(\pounds 502)$ compared to the cost per week of nursing care $(\pounds 734)$.

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
