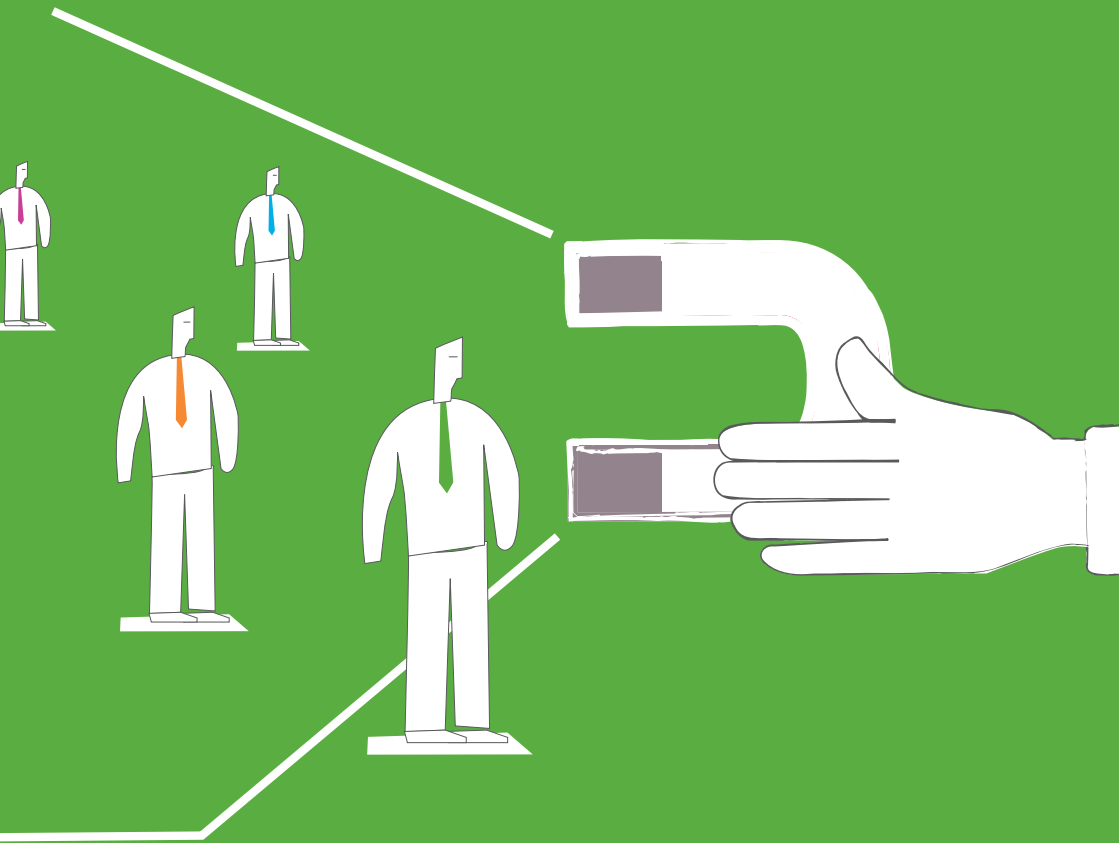

The CIPFA Professional Qualification is the only one designed to equip you with the skills to deal with the complexities, challenges and rigours of the modern public services finance environment.

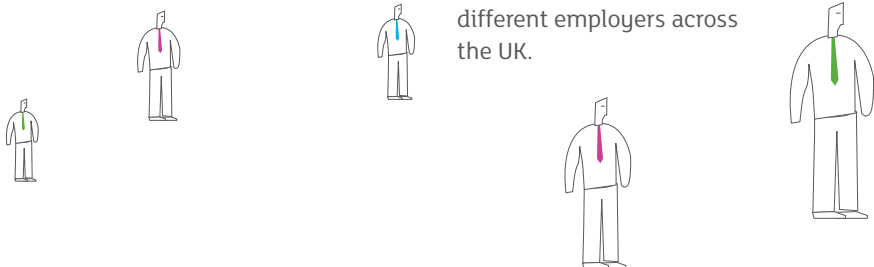
Our 14,000 members work throughout the public services, in national audit agencies, in major accountancy firms, and in other bodies where public money needs to be effectively and efficiently managed.

## Maximise your chances

## Entry requirements

To apply you must satisfy one of the various entry routes into CIPFA:

- 1) **Degree** - from any discipline
- 2) **Full AAT qualification**
- 3) **A level** - 3 GCSE's and 2 A-levels (grades A-C) or equivalent. The Scottish, Northern and Southern Irish equivalents apply. Subjects must include Maths and English at either level.

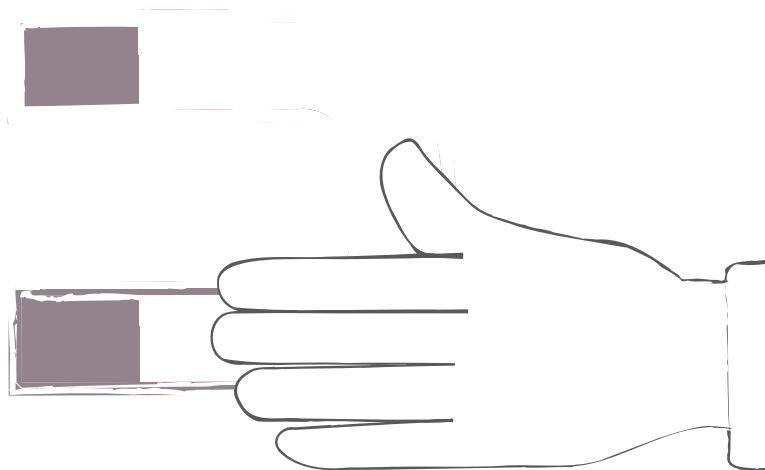
BTEC and SCOTVEC National Certificates are accepted. The minimum vocational qualification is an NVQ/GNVQ at Level 3, or the Scottish equivalent.

- 4) **Work Experience** - you must have at least 3 years' relevant work experience and support from your employer.

## How does it work?

- On completing and submitting your application form, your application will be reviewed against our current vacancies. You will be considered for multiple opportunities if available.
- If successful, a specialist consultant will contact you and provide details of available roles, within 5 working days.
- You will then be invited to undertake a telephone interview lasting 20-30 minutes.
- The final selection event is hosted by the organisation(s) you are applying to. Details of this will be given to you nearer the time.
- Once you have successfully completed the final assessment stage, a training contract is on its way, however, should you find your application unsuccessful, you have the option to be part of our 'talent pool' for consideration against future roles.
