Programme of events

June 2023

A Practitioner's Guide to Public Sector Insurance (All day)

A general guide for practitioners working in public sector insurance. The session is designed for new starters and above as an introduction to the area. The content covers the basis of the insurance contract; procuring insurance for the authority; managing risk; and the use of reserves.



July 2023

Cyber Insurance – An introduction (half Day)

A general guide designed to provide an overview to de-mystify what is often seen as an opaque area of insurance cover. The session will provide a background as to cover, the market, key obligations, disclosure, and claims.



September 2023

A Guide to Highways Claims (half day)

This is a general guide to claims made against highways authorities. The session is designed for new starters and above as an introduction to the area. The session will cover important questions such as: What is a highway? What is not a highway? What duties are in place under S.41 Highways Act 1980? And, what is the statutory Defence under S.58 Highways Act 1980.



November 2023

Effective Procurement of Public Sector Insurance Contracts (half day)

A consideration of the key factors involved in the procurement of public sector insurance. This will consider both the legal framework and the commercial considerations of the process as a whole.



January 2024

A Guide to Disease Claims (half day)

Local authorities and other public sector bodies have significant exposure to disease claims. This is on account of the historic nature of the organisations as employer; their significant and diverse property portfolios; and the nature of services provided. This guide will attempt to provide an outline to how best to deal with these claims, and the various issues that accompany them.



March 2024

The Insurance Act 2015

This session will provide a background as to what important obligations policyholders face under the Insurance Act 2015. This is particularly important in the context of providing the insurer with suitable information at the point of inception.
