

Programme of events

January to February 2019 – Local Authority Accounts Closedown Series 2018/19

April 2019 – Whole of Government Accounts (WGA) Training Webinar (delivered with HM Treasury)

Training for the 2018/19 WGA data submission process is being delivered electronically so you can access the training and seek clarification and guidance from the comfort of your desk

June 2019 – Introduction to Budgeting

This Essentials workshop provides delegates with a good basic understanding of how to set, monitor and report on their local service budgets.
